NECCOG	NECCOG forwarded the forms necessary to participate in the Homeland Security Grant Program to the BOS. The information will be reviewed and acted upon.
17 DEP Trail	The BOS received a copy of a letter from Attorney Londregan to the DEEP asking for a response to his two previous inquiries regarding the ingress and egress from 17 DEP Trail.
State Police Monthly Report	A report of services for the month of September was forwarded to the BOS by Lt. Michael Thomas of the Conn. State Police. The report shows a total of 92 calls for service in Voluntown.
Police Patrols	A copy of a letter from Lt. Michael Thomas answering a citizen's complaint about speeding in the area of Beach Pond Road during pick up and drop off of students was forwarded to the BOS. The letter noted that additional patrols are taking place on Beach Pond Road as well as in the area of the school.
Wilson Road Wells	Mr. Sirpenski noted that he received several inquiries regarding the drawdown of Glasgo Pond and its effect on wells in the area. Mr. Sirpenski has been in touch with Rep. Mikutel who met with representatives from DEEP and the Department of Public Health as well as the governor's office to work on addressing this issue.
STEAP Grant Town Garage	The BOS received a copy of a letter from Rep. Mikutel to Benjamin Barnes, Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management. The letter gave support to the Town's request for a STEAP Grant for the construction of a Public Works Garage.
LoCIP Funds	Approval of funds in the amount of \$45,000.00 from the Local Capital Improvement Program (LoCIP) grant for the Fuel Station was received from the Office of Policy and Management.
