DOT – Curve Safety The DOT notified the BOS of a federal transportation funding program, which requires States who meet the requirements, to obligate funds towards safety projects. The BOS will submit the initial paperwork.

DOT – Bridge Program The DOT notified the BOS that the application period for funding under the State Local Bridge Program is now open. Applications for the program will be accepted until May 15, 2015.
