

**VOLUNTOWN SELECTMEN'S MEETING**  
**Regular Meeting held on June 4, 2013**

**Regular Meeting** The Regular Meeting of the Board of Selectmen was held on Tuesday, June 4, 2013, at the Voluntown Town Hall. Mr. Millovitsch, First Selectman, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

**Approval of Minutes**  
Motion A motion was made (Robert Sirpenski, Ronald Millovitsch) to approve the minutes of the meeting held on May 21, 2013 as submitted. Unanimously voted.

**Citizens Comments**  
Ten Rod Road Attorney Heller presented a survey of a discontinued, Town owned, portion of Ten Rod Road. This portion of road was discontinued in 1936 and Mr. Coleman is petitioning the Town, as an abutting landowner, to convey ownership to him. Attorney Heller, Mr. Coleman, Mr. Faulise and other abutting landowners discussed the option of splitting the road in half between abutting landowners. They agreed to meet in another room so that the BOS could continue their meeting.

Raymond Paradis Mr. Paradis, of Lillibridge Ave., voiced concern about the drainage on his property. Mr. Paradis noted that this has been an on-going issue for years. Mr. Paradis stated that there is a drainage ditch, however, it fills in. Mr. Millovitsch noted that although the Town clears the ditch periodically he is aware of the problem. Mr. Millovitsch will review the current easements and he, Mr. Sirpenski and Mr. Crider (Road Foreman) will review the property.

**Old Business**  
Employment Agreement FF/EMT's The Fire Department has forwarded several recommendations to the Town Attorney and this item will be reviewed when a reply is received.

**Any Other Business**  
State Police The BOS reviewed a letter from the Connecticut State Police Union regarding the consolidation of Troop D (Danielson), Troop E (Montville) and Troop K (Colchester) with Troop C in Tolland. Mr. Millovitsch will contact the State Police regarding this plan.

Employee Handbook Motion A motion was made (Ronald Millovitsch, Robert Sirpenski) to discontinue use of the Employee Handbook until it has been reviewed and updated. Unanimously voted.

Town Beach Mr. Millovitsch noted that he checked the beach this weekend and out of state cars were using the parking area. The BOS will address this issue in the near future.
