Ms. Charlene Perkins Cutler introduced herself to the BOS and explained that The Last Green Valley is a National Heritage Corridor which encompasses thirty-five towns located in Connecticut and Massachusetts. Ms. Cutler reviewed the programs impact on tourism, which totaled \$278 million in 2013. Ms. Hanson noted that the Town is now a member of The Last Green Valley through its Economic Development Commission.

Ms. Perkins Cutler spoke about a project which would post signs on state highways marking the borders of the National Heritage Corridor. She noted that currently visitors cannot tell when they have reached the Corridor. The BOS agreed to draft a letter to Commissioner James P. Redeker of the DOT requesting the signs be installed.
