December 5, 2013

Members present were Lester Davis, Eric Williams, John Moran, Tom Sweet and alternate Tammy Daigneault. Wetlands Agent Joe Theroux was also present. Dave Minor was absent.

Lester Davis, John Moran and Tammy Daigneault were sworn in by the Board Clerk.

In the audience were Michael Schulze, Mr. Gorman and David Smith.

The meeting was called to order at 7:31 p.m.

Additions to the agenda: Terry & Kathy Mandy, 174 North Shore Road.

The minutes from the July, 2013 meeting were read. Lester made a motion to accept the minutes as read, John seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Schedule of meeting dates for 2014 were read and approved by the Board.

New Business: 29 Wylie School Road. Application to repair two bridges that cross wetlands. Michael Schulze is representing the owner Sandra Pellinen. Mr. Schulze presented the Board with a plan of the pre-existing structures and a revised plan to replace and repair the tops of the bridges. They plan to reuse the existing abutments that have weathered the hundred year storm and then put a new top on them. Footings will be put on the outside of the bridges. Additional rip rap will put alongside the bottom of the bridges. Joe Theroux stated that he had already been out to inspect the site and has talked to a few engineers about the project. The board looked over the plans and discussion took place. The board made plans to do a site walk of the property, which will take place on Dec. 18th at 3:30 p.m. Lester made a motion to accept the application, providing that the plans show more detail, John seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

174 North Shore Road. Dave Smith is representing Terry and Kathy Mandy. The application is to repair a retaining wall. Mr. Smith showed the board pictures of the existing wall. The Mandy's would like to break up the existing wall, which is about 60 feet long, and put up a concrete one. They might have to take the deck down because of the erosion behind it. It was suggested that Mr. Smith come back with a more detailed plan showing exactly what is to be done, and making sure silt fencing is in place. Lester made a motion to accept the application for 174 North Shore Road, John seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Agents Report: Joe reported that he has been up to check on the Gibson property at 775 Beach Pond Rd. The drains are being maintained and working well, and the road has been fixed.

Appointment of Chairman: Lester made a motion to nominated Tom Sweet for Chairman. John seconded the motion, all were in favor. As there were no other nominations, Tom Sweet will remain the Chairman.

John made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Eric seconded the motion, all were in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 P.M.
