

**INLAND WETLANDS & WATERCOURSES COMMISSION
TOWN OF VOLUNTOWN**

February 6, 2014.

Members present: Lester Davis, John Moran, Eric Williams & Robert Panko. Wetlands Agent Joe Theroux was also present. Absent: Chairman Tom Sweet, Dave Miner and Alternate Tammy Daigneault.

The meeting was called to order at 7:34 p.m.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read. Lester made a motion to accept, John seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: 29 Wylie School Rd., Sandra Pellinen. Application to repair 2 bridge driveway crossings. There was some discussion by the board while waiting for the applicant to arrive. The next meeting will be sixty days from the date of the original application and they can grant the board a thirty day extension of the application if they are not ready at that time.

AGENT'S REPORT: Joe reported that he stopped by the North Shore Road project and he didn't see any activity there except for the preliminary work. There has been no concrete poured as yet. He took a ride out to Brown Road site and other than the building going on there has been no grading. He will stop and talk with the owners because he is concerned about where the pile of dirt will be put as there is a stream nearby.

Lester mentioned that when he went to check out the Mandy property, he stopped to see another property near there. He mentioned that in the original application for 156 North Shore Road, there was an underdrain that was to be put in and he was wondering if it was because the house looks to be bigger than what the original plan was. Joe stated that he would out and take a look at it.

The applicants did not show up, so they will be put on the agenda for the March meeting as old business.

Mr. Panko is new to the board, so the members brought him up to date on this application. Joe explained to him what the board does and the different kinds of applications that come before the board.

Joe mentioned to the board that it might be feasible to have some kind of document to protect the board from possible liability. The board agreed to have Joe look into this.

John made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Lester seconded it, all in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:48 p.m.
