

INLAND WETLANDS & WATERCOURSES COMMISSION  
TOWN OF VOLUNTOWN  
SPECIAL MEETING

July 11, 2017.

The meeting was called to order at 7:31 p.m. Members present were Chairman Tom Sweet, Dave Miner, Lester Davis and John Moran. Alternates present were Tammy Daigneault and Bob Panko. Wetlands Agent Joe Theroux was present also.

In the audience were Carl Grenier, Jim Thevenet and Patricia Thevenet.

John made a motion to add 88 North Shore Rd. to the agenda under new business, Dave seconded the motion, all in favor.

Attorney Mike Carey sent an email stating that the minutes from the June 1<sup>st</sup> meeting should be amended as follows: the third line from the bottom of the first page should read Attorney Carey did not think off-site easements had to be shown on the application. Dave made a motion to accept the minutes as amended, Lester seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

New Business: Application IWWC 17-02. Patricia Thevenet, 88 North Shore Rd. Mrs. Thevenet would like to grade back the shoreline so she can have better access for swimming. It will be cut back and tapered and the aquatic plants that are growing by the shoreline will be hand raked. Joe has been down there and he said there will be no impact to the pond. The site will be 7 feet wide and 30 feet long. The Commission would like to see sediment control measures shown on the application. Dave made a motion to accept Application IWWC-17-02 for 88 North Shore Rd., John seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Agents Report: Joe reported no major issues. He did talk to Mr. Buckley and he asked if he could get a letter from the Commission stating that the violation on his property was abated. Joe had copies of a letter he drafted which he gave to the board to look over. John made a motion to approve the letter to Mr. Buckley from the board, Lester seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

Joe did mention a piece of property located on Beach Pond Rd. near Two Brothers. The owner had been pushing logs into and near wetlands. The owner told Joe that he wanted to plant trees there and eventually build a house on the site. Joe told him to stop and when the time comes to submit a site plan in the future when he will start to build.

Dave made a motion to adjourn the meeting, John seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
