Mercury Thermostats	Covanta SECONN of Preston forwarded a notice that mercury thermostats are banned from solid waste disposal effective 7/1/14. The Transfer Station does not accept these thermostats and directs residents to dispose of them at the scheduled Hazardous Waste days.
<b>Any Other Business</b> NECCOG	Mr. Gray reported that he has been in contact with NECCOG regarding the possibility of establishing a Hazardous Waste Collection Station that would be open year round. NECCOG is considering a site in Brooklyn, Conn. Mr. Gray will keep the Commission advised.
