A motion was made (John Gileau/Neil Cook) to charge a one dollar (\$1.00) per tire disposal fee at the Transfer Station. Unanimously voted.

Mercury Thermostats Covanta SECONN of Preston forwarded a notice that mercury thermostats are banned from solid waste disposal effective 7/1/14. The Transfer Station does not accept these thermostats and directs residents to dispose of them at the scheduled Hazardous Waste days.

NECCOG Mr. Gray reported that he has been in contact with NECCOG regarding the possibility of establishing a Hazardous Waste Collection Station that would be open year round. NECCOG is considering a site in Brooklyn, Conn. Mr. Gray will keep the Commission advised.
