Minutes of the Meeting held on Wednesday, May 6, 2015, 7:00 PM

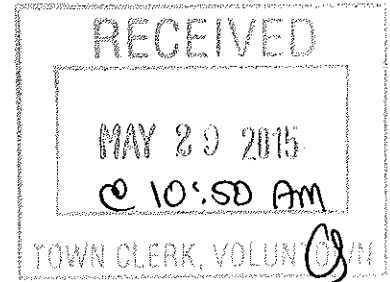
