#### PLAN DESCRIPTION

A Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is a schedule of anticipated capital expenditures over an extended time period. Section 8-160 of the Connecticut General Statutes, which relates to certain state financial aid to municipalities, defines a capital improvement plan as a "priority schedule of any and all necessary municipal capital improvements projected for a period of not less than six years and so prepared as to show the general description, location, and estimated cost of each individual capital improvement and including the proposed method of financing." Capital improvement means a major improvement of betterment of a non-recurring nature to the physical plan of the municipality as differentiated from ordinary repairs of maintenance of a recurring nature.

A CIP is a valuable planning tool for municipal financial planners. When regularly reviewed and updated, it forces local officials to determine equipment and facility needs well in advance of those needs and to schedule expenditures for them in a systematic manner. Early identification of needs allows for better evaluation of cost impacts on the overall municipal budget and provides more time to examine payment options.

To be effective, a CIP must be annually reviewed, updated to reflect changing needs, and extended to cover another year. It is not a simple process of adding additional items to a list. Priorities may be influenced by emergency conditions, unexpected growth, new technology, legislative mandates, or escalating costs.

This CIP reflects capital improvements needed in Voluntown over the next six year period. It is based on information compiled by the Board of Selectmen, and provided to the Board by Voluntown Public Works; the Voluntown Elementary School; the Volunteer Fire Company; the Voluntown Recreation Commission and the Voluntown Public Library.

## CONNECTICUT GENERAL STATUTES APPLICABLE TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Sec. 8-160. Capital improvement programs. Definitions. As used in sections 8-160 to 8-162, inclusive, "capital improvement program" means a priority schedule of any and all necessary municipal capital improvements projected for a period of not less than six years and so prepared as to show the general description, location and estimated cost of each individual capital improvement and including the proposed method of financing; "capital improvement" means a major improvement or betterment of a nonrecurring nature to the physical plant of the municipality as differentiated from ordinary repairs or maintenance of a recurring nature, and "municipality" shall include a city, town or borough.

Sec. 8-161. Commissioner to assist. State payments toward preparation of program. The Commissioner of Housing is authorized to make available technical assistance to any municipality for the purpose of preparing a capital improvement program for such municipality. The commissioner shall adopt rules of procedures and methods of providing such technical assistance. Such assistance shall be rendered upon contractual agreement between the commissioner and the contracting agency of the municipality. Within the limitations of the amounts appropriated, the commissioner may provide up to three thousand dollars for the state's share of any such contractual agreement to any one municipality but in no case shall the commissioner provide more than fifty per cent of the total cost of preparation of such capital improvement program.

Sec. 8-162. Procedure for obtaining technical assistance. Any municipality may receive technical assistance from the Commissioner of Housing for the preparation of a capital improvement program. The legislative body of the municipality by resolution shall designate an appropriate agency of the municipality to prepare the capital improvement program, appropriate the necessary matching funds and authorize such agency to contract with the commissioner for technical assistance therefor as herein provided. If such municipality has a planning commission operating under the general statutes or special act, such planning commission shall be designated to be the contracting agency for such purposes.

# Wylie School House Renovations Committee Project Status Report & 2019/2020 Budget Request Submitted: March 12, 2019

### **Project Status Report:**

Repair/replace rotted woodwork: This phase of the renovation of Wylie School has been completed at a total cost \$ 6,020.00 and included the following:

- ✓ Replaced two front entry thresh-holds, sills and kickplates
- ✓ Replaced bottom window sash and trim sill, window sill and trim
- ✓ Replaced bottom clapboards and water boards
- ✓ Replaced interior floor boards and wall boards
- ✓ Repaired both exterior doors
- ✓ Replaced rotted boards on the outhouses
- ✓ Primed all repaired/replaced items with 1 coat exterior primer

  private citizen for the added cost of \$ 1,070.00 to the original quote of
  \$ 4,950.00

After payment for this project, \$ 2,791.82 remained in the Town's Wylie School maintenance account.

**Priority #1 – Repaint entire exterior:** Two grants applied for by the Voluntown Historical Society were received specifically for this next phase of the renovation, a \$ 4,000 matching grant from The Last Green Valley and a \$ 1,000 grant from the Jewett City Savings Bank Foundation. As TLGV grant included federal funds, approval of the proposed work plan was required and received from the State Historic Preservation Office effective January 10, 2019. The VHS has transferred \$ 5,000 in matching funds to the Town account, which is the extent to which the VHS can assist in funding the renovations. The Committee expresses its deep appreciation to the VHS and, on the Town's behalf, will now pursue any and all grants that may be available to fund needed renovations. This fund transfer brings the total in the maintenance account to \$7,791.82. This amount is sufficient for the deposit of \$5,750 required for work to commence for the removal and on-site mitigation of the exterior leadbased paint by the contractor previously submitting the lowest quote of \$11,500. Payment of this deposit would leave \$ 2,041.82 in the Town account. Once the matching funds are applied to the required deposit, the Town is then qualified for the reimbursement of \$4,000 in grant monies from TLGV. This added to the balance in the Town account would bring that total to \$ 6.041.82, sufficient for the remainder due upon completion of the removal of the lead paint and the priming of the entire exterior in preparation for re-painting. The exterior repainting is estimated to cost @ \$ 2,000 unless materials and labor can be donated.

However, should the re-painting not be done via donations, then what would remain in the Town account (\$291.82) is insufficient to move forward with the re-painting without additional funding in the Town's 2019/2020 budget and/or through additional grants.

Priority #2 – Repair exterior and interior wiring: In addition to an evaluation of the exterior damage to the wiring that occurred in the winter storms of 2017, the Committee requests that, due to the building's age and inherent safety concerns, an inspection by the Town Building Inspector be done followed by the submission of a report with requirements and recommendations for necessary repairs and renovations to the electrical wiring. Current estimates based on a walk-through by a licensed electrician are \$ 2,800.00. This would require additional funding by the Town in the 2019/2020 budget and/or through additional grants.

**Priority #3 – Repair chimney and stove:** To facilitate the public's use and enjoyment of the Wylie School House throughout the year, the safe operational use of the wood stove is a priority. The estimated cost of @ \$ 2,000.00 for meeting all requirements by inspection of the VFD Fire Chief is proposed to be funded as part of the 2020/2021 Town budget and/or through additional grants.

Priority #4 – Repair/replace the bell, yoke and stand – This phase of the renovation process awaits examination and assessment by Greg Farmer of the CT Historical Trust to ascertain if historical preservation criteria apply and whether repair or recasting of the bell is required. The size and weight of the bell is going to require a heavy yoke and stand (broken as a result of the 2017 storms) at an estimated cost of \$ 1,800.00 plus additional shipping costs of @ \$ 300 if applicable. Any estimated costs would be proposed to be funded in the 2020/2021 Town budget and/or through additional grants.

**Priority #5 — Replace the flagpole —** It is anticipated that the flagpole can be replaced through donations or cost-free.
