- Meeting** The Special Meeting of the Board of Selectmen was held via Zoom on Monday, May 18, 2020. Ms. Hanson, First Selectman, called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

- Budget 20/21** Ms. Hanson attended the Board of Education meeting on Thursday May 14, 2020. The Board of Education approved a zero increase in their BOE budget for FY 20/21. The Board of Selectmen went through the budget and decided to add \$30,000 to the revenue budget for Special Education. There has been a minimum received for special education for the past 10 years and has not been listed on the Revenue Budget. Because of this there will be no mill rate increase for FY 20/21. The Capital Projects Budget will remain the same. This will leave us with a 12.5% unassigned fund balance which is on the higher side. The upcoming fiscal year could be a difficult one with the prospects of extra Covid-19 expenses and possible revenue shortfalls. There are a few funding sources from the Cares Act and the State but there have been no decisions yet on how that money will be distributed.
