

# Public Works Report

October 11, 2022

The following items are what Public Works is currently working on:

- General turf maintenance through the soccer season and weekly trash disposal ongoing.
- Currently mowing Sand hill Road, next is the Village District.
- Completed snow management road master class with the UCONN t2 center.
- Salt contract is signed.
- Bassett Mill drainage and paving is still being finished- curbing.
- Bennett Circle- curbing still to be finished.
- Basset Mill and Bennett Circle should be done by the end of the month before the paving plants close for the winter.
- Our current Salt Shed is usable. We are looking into the future design/location. The current salt shed has a 10-year lifespan and we are currently on year 5.
- Flail mower (over the rail mower) head being worked on at the garage.
- Snow season equipment preparation is ongoing. Truck 2 and truck 3 (two oldest) are out for repair. Truck 5 is out for seasonal warranty maintenance.
- Working on the f550 (truck 3) replacement specs. Trucks are out for order several years.
- Observed Pavement Rejuvenation treatment in Woodstock.
- Retained BETA Engineering to do 3<sup>rd</sup> party road evaluation. We have started working with them.
- Worked with the Finance Director and First Selectman to prioritize future expenditures.
- Evaluated Lakeside Terrace and Tanglewood Drive drainage.
- Procured a guide pole driver attachment for the backhoe
- Procured traffic/safety signs
- Winter fuel treatment has begun.
